Hartford HealthCare is the premiere health care network in Connecticut with 15,000 employees and \$2 billion in net revenue. The HHC system includes Hartford Hospital; The Hospital of Central Connecticut; MidState Medical Center; Windham Hospital; The Institute of Living psychiatric center; VNA HealthCare; Clinical Laboratory Partners with more than 80 locations statewide; Hartford Medical Group; MidState Medical Group; the Doctors of Central Connecticut; Central Connecticut Senior Health Services, which includes five assisted-living and skilled-nursing facilities; Eastern Rehabilitation Network; and two regional behavioral health centers, Rushford and Natchaug Hospital.

Mr. Marchozzi oversees the fiscal operations of all organizations in the Hartford HealthCare System throughout the State of Connecticut.

He has extensive demonstrated experience in managing health care systems, academic medical institutions, large tertiary care facilities and teaching hospitals. Using his concentrated experience in the areas of business analysis, planning, budgeting, forecasting, and information systems, he has been deeply involved in large-scale redesign processes to expand hospitals with new patient towers, emergency departments, outpatient facilities and physician joint ventures.

Before joining Hartford HealthCare, Mr. Marchozzi served as Senior Vice President and CFO at the Washington Hospital Center in Washington, D.C. Prior to that, he served as Vice President for Finance with Med Star Health, an integrated health care delivery system in Maryland and Washington, D.C. Earlier in his career, he worked in the Jefferson Health System in Radnor, Penn., where he last served as acting CFO and Treasurer.

Mr. Marchozzi earned a Master of Business Administration with a concentration in finance from Villanova University, Villanova, Penn. and a Bachelor of Business Administration from Drexel University in Philadelphia. He was named the 2011 CFO of the year for nonprofit organizations by the *Hartford Business Journal*.
